Included also are a few steam excursion runs with the Southern Rwy #4501, Canadian National 6218, and NKP 759.

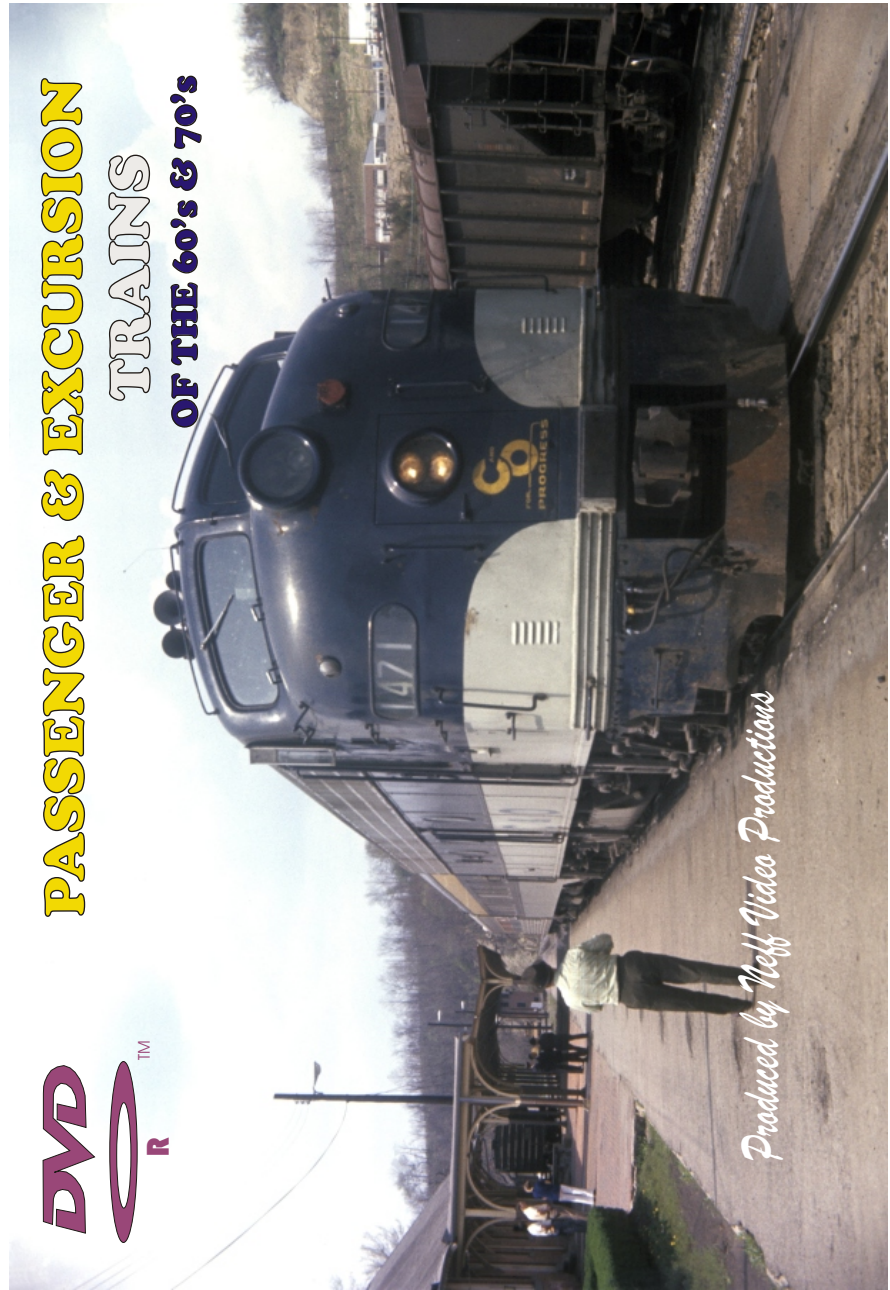
